### The Venue



Camp is held at the Indoor Karting Centre at the Dubai Autodrome, Motor City. Housed in the massive facility adjacent to the Outdoor Circuit, the Indoor Circuit is approximately 620 meters long and can accommodate up to ten drivers on track at any one time. Other activities at the indoor Kartdrome include Laserdrome, Playstation Alley, RaceRoom Sim Racing and billiards. A selection of food and beverages are available on site, provided by Zoom.

### Arriving at Camp

Gulf Star requests that all children and students are registered and collected daily by a parent or guardian (over the age of 18). Gulf Star will hand over from inside the Indoor Karting Centre at the Gulf Star registration desk. You will be greeted by the Gulf Star team (the guys and girls in navy blue t-shirts) and your child will be given a group name so that they are with their friends from the outset.

The desk is located near the entrance of the venue and will be sign posted. There is also a bag drop area which will be within view from the main meeting area. On all of our camps, there is a set-a-side first aid area that we use for the entire period. There is also lost property, so please do regularly check this because all lost property is deposited to charity boxes at the end of the holiday camp period.

Groups are assigned according to child's age in order to keep friends together and to create a perfect environment for team activities and fair play. We do not over complicate groups, if siblings wish to stay together we have no problem with this and there is movement between groups throughout the week to keep everyone happy.

Gulf Star staff will be available to talk to parents should there be additional questions or extra requirements



### Activities

The camp is tournament focused so everything has a purpose. Every day points are accumulated for all the activities and at the end of the week we present overall winners and runners up and exceptional performances in the activities.

Karting, Lasertag & Raceroom Simulators are the main features and they occupy the main part of the day.

#### KARTING

Groups will be receiving driving tuition from the experts at the Dubai Autodrome centre and then free race time is given in order to practice what they have learned. Karting will take place every day on the indoor track. On Thursdays we finish with a big grand prix style ending and the kids will get the chance to take what they have learned in practice into the epic final race day. It is proven that students improve throughout the week the proof is seen in their race times.



#### LASER TAG

Laser tag will also take place every day and this too incorporates points towards the overall champion of the week. There are plenty of games based on individual and group challenges as kids battle it out in the medieval maze!

#### RACEROOM SIMULATORS

We have also recently incorporated the simulators onto our camp and these feature on Tuesdays. Kids have the opportunity to life behind the wheel of one of over 40 iconic one of 25 world renowned race tracks!

#### OTHER ACTIVITIES

The Indoor Karting centre is also equipped with pool tables and a sony playstation zone and the kids are free to use these during down time sessions. We will also play a number of fun team games and competitions to maximize the kids fun at camp!

### Snack Times

Your child will have the opportunity to break for one snack time and a lunch break, during their day.

Food is **not** included on the camp and we recommend that children bring their own healthy snacks and lunch. There is also a Zoom Market at the venue, and children can purchase selected lunch and snack items during the day.

During the camp children will not be allowed to swap food with each other and we have a 'no nuts' policy on our camps. Drinking water will be available at all times throughout the day, for your child to refill their water bottle.

**What should your child bring to the camp at Dubai Autodrome holiday camp?**

Your child needs to bring the following everyday:

- Lunch and a snack
- Refillable water bottle
- Trainers or pumps and socks (not flip flops)
- A spare T-shirt (optional)
- A towel (optional)

**Camp Information**

**If you or your Child has travelled to the following countries within the last 14 days they will not be able to attend camp - China, Hong Kong, South Korea, Iran, Japan, Singapore, Italy. On the first day there will be a self-declaration form that will need to be signed by all parents.**

**Age:** Gulf Star Kartdrome Camps are suitable for children aged 7-15 years old

**Restrictions:** Minimum height of 1.25m to drive the Junior Sodi LR4 Karts, Race overalls and a full face helmet fitted with a clear visor must be worn at all times, closed-toe shoes must be worn; no sandals allowed.

**Disclaimer:** Parent/legal guardian is required to complete a disclaimer upon arrival on the first morning of camp. All participants must have a valid ID (Emirates ID or passport) to kart.

**Prices:** Camp is charged at AED 980 for the one child with a special early bird rate of 900 AED when booked at least in advance. Prices are inclusive of VAT. Booking siblings or multiple weeks can also avail the early bird rate. Limited spaces are available per week. Individual day rates are available upon request.

**Timings:** Gulf Star Kartdrome camp runs from 9am to 1pm

**Early Drop Off:** For Parents' convenience, 8am drop off is available at a cost of AED 1,000 per child per week including the camp fee or 270 AED per day per child including the daily camp fee (inclusive of VAT)
