ARRIVING AT CAMP

Camp Schedule

The camp is tournament focused so everything has a purpose. Every day points are accumulated for all the activities and at the end of the week we present overall winners and runners up and exceptional performances in the activities.

Karting and Lasertag are the main features and they occupy the main part of the day.



What should your child bring to the camp at Dubai Autodrome holiday camp?

Your child needs to bring the following everyday:

Groups will be receiving driving session from the experts at the Dubai Autodrome centre and then free race time is given in order to practice what they have learned. Karting will take place every day on the indoor track. On Thursdays we finish with a big grand prix style ending and the kids will get the chance to take what they have learned in practice into the epic final race day. It is proven that students improve throughout the week the proof is seen in their race times.

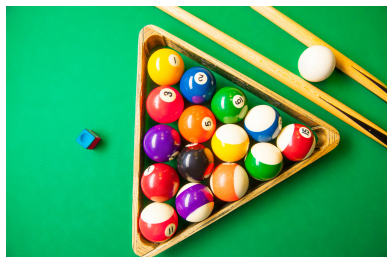


Laser Tag

Restrictions
