ARRIVING AT CAMP

Gulf Star requests that all children are registered and collected daily by a parent or guardian (over the age of 18). Registration must be made in advance on this link bookings.gulfstarsports.com/camps.

Upon arrival at the venue you will be greeted by the Gulf Star team (the guys and girls in navy blue t-shirts) and your child will be given a name badge to distinguish their individuality so that they can make friends easier. To avoid crowding we will ask parents to drop their children and leave, to reduce the number of parents on site a any one time.

Groups will be receiving driving tuition from the experts at the Dubai Autodrome centre and then free race time is given in order to practice what they have learned. Karting will take place every day on the indoor track. On Thursdays we finish with a big grand prix style ending and the kids will get the chance to take what they have learned in practice into the epic final race day. It is proven that students improve throughout the week the proof is seen in their race times.



Laser tag will also take place every day

SNACK TIMES
